REPORT OF PHILLIONTHRAPIST PROJECT Supported By STEUNPAKISTAN, M/S Fancy Foundation, Mr. Shabbir Bilwani

VILLAGE MARO KHAN TALPUR

INITIAL IDENTIFICATION of VILLAGE

Before starting work our teams visited and assess the condition of the villages after flood like their house hold, population, literacy rate and their basic facilities (water, health and education).

HANDS initial survey about the condition of villages and with the help of community HANDS identified poorest of the poor to rehabilitate. The criterion of HANDS village selection was established in which it was necessary to select a village which has been damaged more than 70%. After the situation analysis the village selected for Model Village and then HANDS started to develop list of beneficiaries for shelters through CBO of this village. During the evaluation it was found that many widows were there who had no shelter and there was not any source of income for them to fulfill their basic needs.

Background of Village Maro Khan Talpur

The village Maro Khan Talpur located on the Right side of Super High way while going towards Dadu. 10 KM away from HANDS Office Sehwan in UC Channa Taulka Sehwan District Jamshoro total Population of this Village is 640 with house hold 100. Maro Khan Talpur historical background assumed 100 years back, all people have blood relations and their language is Balochi. The earned their livings through agriculture and livestock.



Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA)

The technique of assessment called Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) was employed to assess the village and has developed village development plan.

CBO FORMATION

Before starting work at Maro Khan Talpur it was so necessary to form a CBO (Community Based Organization), therefore an election of CBO members was held by the people of village in which President, Vice President, General Secretary, Information Secretary, Finance Secretary and other four members have been elected and selected by and in the favor of people of village.







CBO AGREEMENT

An agreement was signed between HANDS and CBO Members of village Maro Khan Talpur in which 63 Shelters has been handed over to people of village Maro Khan Talpur. Total cost of each shelter is PKR 110000, in which 10 % of total cost has been paid by the beneficiary and remaining cost by the HANDS.

WORK STARTED AT MARO KHAN TALPUR

After a successful assessment and CBO agreement, work of construction was started on 20th February 2011 and contract of 63 houses was

given to a contractor named Khan Insaf Ali Jhatial.


COMPLETION of SHELTER AT MARO KHAN TALPUR

By the grace of Allah construction work at village Maro khan Talpur has completed on 16th May

2011. There were 63 houses were completed in which 40 houses were of support from Stitching Steunt Pakistan. List of beneficiaries attached with their National Identification Card Number.

Specification of Shelter:

One room shelter having small veranda, washroom and kitchen. Further technical specification enclosed here.



After completion of work of shelters at Maro khan Talpur, a ceremony function was held by the HANDS on 17th May 2011 in which Shelters were handed over to beneficiaries in the presence of Chairman HANDS Dr. Abdul Ghaffar Billoo, CEO Dr. Shaikh Tanveer Ahmed and Chief Guest Mr. Nawab Abdul Ghani Talpur (MNA OF VILLAGE). Where as representative from Stiching Steunt Pakistan Dr. Tufail was also present on the occasion. Villagers and house owners were showed their



happiness and gratitude on completion of this project, which they showed during the ceremony.







OTHER WORK AT MARO KHAN TALPUR:

As hands is working for rehabilitation with integrated approach and it is included in development plan of every model village that the villagers must be supported in receiving health, education and livelihood services. In this village apart from shelter provision HANDS mange to provide school building renovation through ISAR project and health

intervention through Community Management of Acute Malnutrition Project, while rebuilding of village Mosque is one the blessing of God.

But still there are many areas to work further, in which water reservoir, livelihood support, Community Infrastructure (CPI) like pavement, streets. There are many people who are waiting for the support of income generation to earn their living by dignity. Save drinking water is one of the biggest challenge of the village which has been identified by CBO too because water available there has arsenic poisoned in it.

Although livelihood, CPI and water support has also in the village plan. HANDS is trying to generate resource to meet these requirements of villagers and look forward to donors and philanthropists.
